You are entitled to receive information about the methods of therapy, the techniques used, the duration of therapy (if known) and the fee structure. You may seek a second opinion from another therapist or may terminate therapy at any time. In a professional relationship, sexual intimacy is never appropriate and should be reported to the grievance board.

The information provided during therapy sessions is legally confidential in the case of licensed clinical social workers, except as provided in section 12.43.218. Exceptions to confidentiality include: suspected abuse/neglect, suicidal or homicidal threats or a court order.

For clinical emergencies of a life threatening nature after hours, please contact 911 or your closest hospital emergency room. Under most circumstances, I will return non-emergent calls within 24 hours on weekdays and within 48 hours over weekends.
